



The Third Temple

Isa 14:12

How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *how* art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

Isa 14:13

For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of Alahayim: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

Psa 48:2

Beautiful for situation, the joy of the whole earth, *is* mount Zion, *on* the sides of the north, the city of the great King

Dan 8:23

And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

Dan 8:24

And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power:
and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people

Dan 11:45

And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain;

2Th 2:4

Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called Alahayim, or that is worshipped; so that he as Alahayim sitteth in the temple of Alahayim, shewing himself that he is Alahayim

Ascension of Isaiah 3:6-9,13

6. And he will do everything he wishes in the world; he will act and speak like the Beloved, and will say, "I am Lord, and before me there was no one. "

7. And all men in the world will believe in him.

8. And they will sacrifice to him and will serve him saying: "This is Lord and beside him there is no other."



9. And the majority of those who have associated together to receive the Beloved, he will turn aside after him.

13. And many faithful and saints, when they saw Him for whom they were hoping, who was crucified, Yache the Lord Christ—after that I, Isaiah, had seen Him who was crucified and ascended— and who believed in him, of these few will be left in those days as His servants, while they flee from desert to desert, as they await his coming.

2 Baruch 32:1-3,5-6, 4

1 'But as for you, if you prepare thy hearts, so as to sow in them the fruits of the law, it shall protect you in that time in which the Mighty One is to shake the whole creation. 2 [Because after a little time the building of Zion will be shaken in order that it may be built again. But that building will not remain, but will again after a time be rooted out, and will remain desolate until the time.

5 Therefore we should not be distressed so much over the evil which has now come as over that which is still to be. 6 For there will be a greater trial than these two tribulations when the Mighty One will renew His creation.

4 And afterwards it must be renewed in glory, and perfected for evermore.]

Barnabas 16:6

But let us enquire whether there be any temple of Alahayim. There is; in the place where he himself undertakes to make and finish it. For it is written And it shall come to pass, when the week is being accomplished, the temple of Alahayim shall be built gloriously in the name of the Lord.

Barnabas 6:13-15

Barnabas 6:13

Again I will shew thee how the Lord speaketh concerning us. He made a second creation at the last; and the Lord saith; Behold I make the last things as the first. In reference to this then the prophet preached; Enter into a land flowing with milk and honey, and be masters over it.

Barnabas 6:14

Behold then we have been created anew, as He saith again in another prophet; Behold, saith the Lord, I will take out from these, that is to say, from those whom the Spirit of the Lord foresaw, their stony hearts, and will put into them hearts of flesh; for He Himself was to be manifested in the flesh and to dwell in us.

Barnabas 6:15

For a holy temple unto the Lord, my brethren, is the abode of our heart.



Barnabas 16:7

I find then that there is a temple, How then shall it be built in the name of the Lord? Understand ye. Before we believed on Alahayim, the abode of our heart was corrupt and weak, a temple truly built by hands; for it was full of idolatry and was a house of demons, because we did whatsoever was contrary to Alahayim.

Barnabas 16:8

But it shall be built in the name of the Lord. Give heed then that the temple of the Lord may be built gloriously.

Barnabas 16:9

How? Understand ye. By receiving the remission of our sins and hoping on the Name we became new, created afresh from the beginning.

Wherefore Alahayim dwelleth truly in our habitation within us. How? The word of his faith, the calling of his promise, the wisdom of the ordinances, the commandments of the teaching, He Himself prophesying in us, He Himself dwelling in us, opening for us who had been in bondage unto death the door of the temple, which is the mouth, and giving us repentance leadeth us to the incorruptible temple.

Barnabas 16:10

For he that desireth to be saved looketh not to the man, but to Him that dwelleth and speaketh in him, being amazed at this that he has never at any time heard these words from the mouth of the speaker, nor himself ever desired to hear them. This is the spiritual temple built up to the Lord.

Barnabas 17:1

So far as it was possible with all simplicity to declare it unto you, my soul hopeth that I have not omitted anything [of the matters pertaining unto salvation and so failed in my desire].

1Pe 2:1-5

Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,

1Pe 2:2

As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:

1Pe 2:3

If so be ye have tasted that the Lord *is* gracious.

1Pe 2:4

To whom coming, *as unto* a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of Alahayim, *and* precious,



1Pe 2:5

Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to Alahayim by Yache Christ.

Revelation 21:10, 22-27

10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from Alahayim,

Revelation 21:22

And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord Alahayim Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

Revelation 21:23

And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of Alahayim did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.

Revelation 21:24

And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.

Revelation 21:25

And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.

Revelation 21:26

And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it.

Revelation 21:27

And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
