

The Abomination of Desolation notes

Daniel 12:11

[11] And from the time {that} the daily {sacrifice} shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, {there shall be} a thousand two hundred and ninety days.

Daniel 11:31

31 And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily {sacrifice}, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate.

I Macc 1:54, 59

[54] Now the fifteenth day of the twelveth month, in the hundred forty and fifth year, they set up the abomination of desolation upon the altar, and builded idol altars throughout the cities of Juda on every side; [59] Now the five and twentieth day of the month they did sacrifice upon the idol altar, they did sacrifice upon the idol altar, which was upon the altar of Alahayim

Mark 13:14

[14] But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:

Daniel 12:11

2 Baruch 35:1,4

II Sam 5:6-7

6 And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither. 7 Nevertheless David took the strong hold of Zion: the same {is} the city of David.

I Chron 21:15,26-29

15 And Alahayim sent an angel unto Jerusalem to destroy it: and as he was destroying, Ahayah beheld, and he repented him of the evil, and said to the angel that destroyed, It is enough, stay now thine hand. And the angel of Ahayah stood by the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

26 And David built there an altar unto Ahayah, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called upon Ahayah; and he answered him from heaven by fire upon the altar of burnt offering.

27 And Ahayah commanded the angel; and he put up his sword again into the sheath thereof.

28 At that time when David saw that Ahayah had answered him in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite, then he sacrificed there.

29 For the tabernacle of Ahayah, which Moses made in the wilderness, and the altar of the burnt offering, {were} at that season in the high place at Gibeon

1 Chron 22:1

1 Then David said, this is is the house of Ahayah Alahayim, and this {is} the altar of the burnt offering for Israel.

II Chron 3:1

1 Then Solomon began to build the house of Ahayah at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where {Ahayah} appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.
